In Loving Memory of William R. "Billy" Bybee

November 28, 1937 - January 23, 2025



Thursday January 23, 2025 was a day in which Bill Bybee had prepared himself when his spirit would cross over from this earth to go be with the Lord. Billy submitted his life to Jesus Christ many years ago when he obeyed the gospel. For the rest of his life, he proclaimed the saving message of the gospel of Christ to help others become a Christian and live faithfully to go to heaven. He was a diligent student of God's Word, constantly studying deeper and deeper in the scriptures. He was a great preacher and teacher. Billy could be very serious when it came to spiritual matters, but he also had a great sense of humor. When he came into the church building I often would say "it's great to see you!" His reply would usually be "it's good to be seen." His last regular ministry he served as the preacher at the Shady Grove Church of Christ for 53 years until his health declined. He served as one of the shepherds here at Horse Cave for 36 years. His death leaves a huge vacancy in his family and our church family. A vast wealth of knowledge has vanished with his passing.

We extend our deepest sympathy to his wife of 66 years, Janice Sue, to his son Ken Bybee (Monica) and daughter Temisha Denison (Bryan), grandchildren Dylan Vance (Phillip), Will Bybee (Lauren), Braden Bybee, great-grandchildren Rhealyn, Brentlee, Kade, Arial, Aliyah, Alexann, Tristan, sister-in-laws, Peggy Bybee and Helen Edwards.

I have greatly respected and appreciated our friendship over the years, especially the 22 years of my ministry here at Horse Cave. He leaves a rich heritage for his family to carry on as his parents Roscoe and Lucille Bybee left him.
