The Hope Laid up for You by Phil Sanders

We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints, because of the hope laid up for you in heaven (Colossians 1:3-5a).

Faith, hope, and love are inseparable. Paul said in 1 Corinthians 13:13, "So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love." Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy said to the church at Thessalonica, "We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Thessalonians 1:2-3).

Having a hope laid up in heaven will deepen our faith in and love for Christ and our brothers and sisters in Christ. "For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ; who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself" (Philippians 3:20-21).

Heaven is sweeter because of who is there and who will be there when we enter in for eternity. Hope for heaven and fixed on Christ's second coming causes us to purify ourselves in preparation for Him (1 John 3:2-3).

With faith, hope, and love we live for the Lord and can die for the Lord, because we belong to the Lord (Romans 14:7-9). We walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).

The Message Preached by Phil Sanders

For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not come to know God, God was well-pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe (1 Corinthians 1:21).

God chose to save our souls through the message preached, that message is the gospel (Romans 1:16). The gospel is the seed of the kingdom (Luke 8:11); it is an imperishable seed that causes us to be born again (1 Peter 1:22-23). We must receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save our souls (James 1:21).

While Peter was given utterance by the Holy Spirit to speak on Pentecost to the guilty souls who crucified Jesus (Acts 2:4, 36), it was Peter's message that convicted the hearts of those who heard (Acts 2:37). When they asked what to do, Peter told them (Acts 2:38-39).

When an angel and the Holy Spirit guided Philip to join the chariot of the Ethiopian eunuch, Philip preached Jesus to him. In response to the preaching, the eunuch asked to be baptized (Acts 8:35-36). Though Jesus appeared to Saul of Tarsus on the road to Damascus, He told Saul to go into Damascus, "and it will be told you what you must do" (Acts 9:6). Ananias told him to "be baptized and wash away his sins" (Acts 22:16).

People today, just as in the first century, are saved when they hear and respond to the gospel message. The message preached is God's plan for touching hearts and changing lives!

That's How He Hurt His Hands

Many have seen little boys plucking flowers to give to their adoring mothers. A little known song recounts a story of a small boy who came running to his mother with tears streaming down his cheeks. He clutched a rose that he had picked as a gift for her. The tears were because he had cut his hands on the thorny stems of the beautiful red roses. The song's refrain says, "He was showing his love, and that's how he hurt his hands."

In my mental images of Jesus, I often think about His hands and how He used them to show love to others. With his hands, He cleansed a leper (Matthew 8:3). He placed His hands on the tongue and ears of the deaf mute, causing him to hear and speak. With His hands, He gave sight to the blind (Mark 8:23). He extended His hand to rescue Peter (Matthew 14:31). To a maiden asleep in death, His hand had the power of life (Mark 5:41).

At no time were those hands more precious or more loving than when they were nailed to the cross for you and me. Those bleeding hands, that bloody brow, and His stricken back were given as a sacrifice for my many
