A Confused Society

"For those who guide this people are leading them astray; And those who are guided by them are brought to confusion" (Isaiah 9:16).

In the eighth century before the time of Christ, God was angry at Israel for its lofty pride and arrogance of heart. The people had been led astray by their godless elders and priests, who had begun to speak wicked foolishness and were evildoers (9:17). They left the people confused about God and about sin. Many religious groups have leaders who teach things far from the biblical instructions found in the New Testament.

Postmodern America in these recent years is also confused. The Family Research Council in a survey of 1000 churchgoers found there was "widespread confusion about the most basic truths of the Christian faith—about who God is, what sin is, and how someone is saved" (A National Survey of Churchgoing Americans, Family Research Council & Cultural Research Center).

The survey found only "54% of churchgoers say the Bible is true or inspired, error-free Word of God." Fewer than half believe the Bible speaks clearly on homosexuality. Barely half say it is clear on abortion. One in three (32%) churchgoers now prefer socialism over capitalism. Socialism holds no place for God.

People today need clear teaching from the Word of God to answer their confusion. At SEARCH we are committed to teaching the truth on these basics, because we want to be faithful to our duty to serve God and teach the truth. This generation needs a firm footing that leads them to truth and righteousness.

Please join with us in this ministry to get the Word out to a lost and dying world. Keep us in your prayers. May the Lord be with you, Phil Sanders
