We're Part of the Family

We sometimes sing a song with the same title as this article. It points out that we've been born again, we love each other, we belong to Christ, and we're headed home together. How wonderful!

Think about this: we really are part of the family! We don't just visit once in a while. The Lord's church is a family – the "house (family) of God, which is the church of the living God" (1 Timothy 3:15). As Christians, we "are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God" (Ephesians 2:19). Christians are brothers and sisters of the same Heavenly Father (2 Corinthians 6:18).

As a part of God's family, you do not just "visit" your fellow-Christians. Two things spring to mind. First, some brothers and sisters act like visitors because their attendance is so sporadic. When they happen to show up, their presence is unexpected and surprising (like having company drop in). Certainly we're thrilled to see them, but we can't count on them to be here next time we meet.

Family members are expected to be "home" on a regular basis. Generally, they do not have to be begged, cajoled, wheedled, and otherwise pressured to come home. When they are absent for prolonged periods for no compelling reason, the rest of the family naturally becomes concerned.

Second, even some Christians who

attend on a regular basis behave more like visitors than family members. They do not pitch in to help with the work (not just in the assembly, but throughout the week). Rather, they expect others to wait on them, fuss over them, check on them, and pat them on the head. Just fail to pamper them, and watch the fur fly! These have not learned what Jesus taught: "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve" (Mark 10:45a).

Most families expect every member to do his/her part of the necessary tasks to keep the household running smoothly. Even so, every Christian ought to welcome opportunities to serve, rather than looking for reasons to be offended because "they didn't treat me right." Likening the church to a human body, Paul said that "the whole body [is] joined together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share" (Ephesians 4:16).

Christian, how blessed you are to be part of God's family! Don't just visit once in a while – come 'home' regularly, and participate in the family activities. You'll be happier, the church will grow, and our God will be glorified!
