## Hide Behind the Cross

As a child, I fondly recall hearing faithful brethren pray in the assembly, "Father, be with our speaker that he may hide himself behind the cross of Christ." This sentiment expresses the importance of those preaching the gospel to do so humbly, exalting Christ and His Word. Many that stand in our pulpits will often preach to exalt themselves by using human eloquence and their personal charisma to sway the audience.

Since the gospel is "God's power unto salvation" (Rom. 1:16), it behooves all that preach to do so in a manner, which gives tribute to the author of our redemption. Paul states, "For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus sake" (2 Cor. 4:5). All who preach the unsearchable riches of Christ must never forget to hide themselves behind the cross. The only way God's power will be realized is through the faithful proclamation of the gospel. Preachers, who introduce human wisdom as a substitute for declaring Christ and Him crucified, have failed to hide behind the cross (I Cor. 1:23).

All too often congregations disperse at the conclusion of the worship service, asking, "What was the aim of the preacher's discourse this morning? Paul, the apostle, wrote the words: "For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of; for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I "preach" not the gospel" (I Cor. 9:16).

## Religion "Lite" by Charlie Gamble

Many of the refreshments we enjoy are different from a few years ago. They are now offered in diet or "lite" formulas. The original has been modified to appeal to the consumer's wishes. This can be a good thing in refreshments but, in religion, it is not.

We are never to change God's original formula in order to appeal to the consumer. Instead, the consumer is to change their formula for life to include: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. Eccl 12:13b (NKJV) Today our commandments are revealed in the New Testament. We are not to accept any other gospel whether an addition to or a subtraction from that which is written. (Gal 1:6-10)

Sorrowfully, some have decided to go "lite" in order to appeal to the religious consumer. Some are teaching salvation "lite" (no baptism). Some offer worship "lite" (no Lord's Supper). Many practice commitment "lite" (no attendance). There are many other examples of this trend. Jesus said, "I am the light of the world: he that follows me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."

So, what do you choose: the light of life or the "lite" of darkness?
