Too Late!

Every one of us has been there. Maybe you were going to buy that table while the furniture store had the price marked down; but you put it off, and by the time you arrived, the sale was over. Or perhaps you wanted tickets to hear your favorite singer, but by the time you tried to purchase them, the concert was sold out. You can get by without the table and the tickets, but waiting until it's "too late" to prepare for eternity is tragic beyond measure!

The rich man (Luke 16:19) had the best that money could buy in this world, but he was unprepared for eternity. His behavior showed no concern for God, and no kindness toward Lazarus, the poor beggar who sat starving at his gate. When the rich man died and found himself in torments in Hades while Lazarus rested in the bosom of Abraham, he cried out for mercy (vv. 23-24). But, alas, it was too late! Not one drop of water to cool his parched tongue - no, not even this miniscule measure of comfort would be granted to him! He had shown no mercy in life, and he would receive none after death. How sad, that he waited until it was too late to seek mercy!

Since he could not change his own eternal fate, perhaps he could at least do something for his brothers who were still alive. He pleaded that Lazarus be sent back to warn them. But again, the answer

was "no"! They had the word of God to warn them; if they would not heed it, neither would they listen to someone who returned from the dead. But again we wonder, where was his concern for his brothers while he was alive? Not until it was too late did he give serious consideration to their eternal welfare.

Dear reader, what about you? Are you prepared for eternity? Most of us spend a good deal more time and effort preparing for retirement than we do preparing to meet God in judgment. Like the rich man, however, our wealth cannot save us, but will condemn us if we misuse it. Now is the time to believe & obey the gospel! Salvation is too precious to risk waiting until it is too late.

Christian friend, what about your relatives, friends, and acquaintances? Are you reaching out to them with the gospel while time and opportunity are yours? They are depending on you to help them learn the Lord's way. If you wait until it is too late, how will you explain your neglect to them when they are lost on the day of judgment? Furthermore, how will you explain it to God? "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (2 Corinthians 6:2).

Think About It

If a matter is not serious enough to pray about, then it is not serious enough to worry about — and if it is serious enough to pray about, and we have prayed about it, then there is not need to worry about it.
