# Blind Leaders of the Blind

Jesus said of the Pharisees, "They are blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both will fall into a ditch" (Matthew 15:13, 14).

After a while, the plow stopped. The driver came over to the car and asked, "Mister where are you headed?" The man answered, "I'm on my way to Montana." The snowplow man said, "Well, you'll never get there following me. I'm plowing out this parking lot!"
